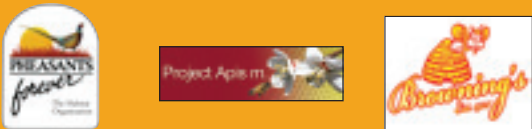

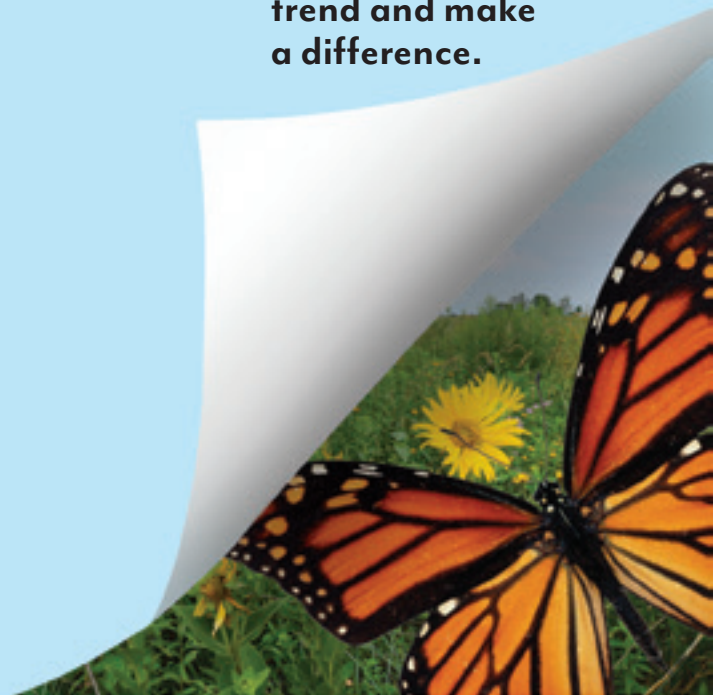

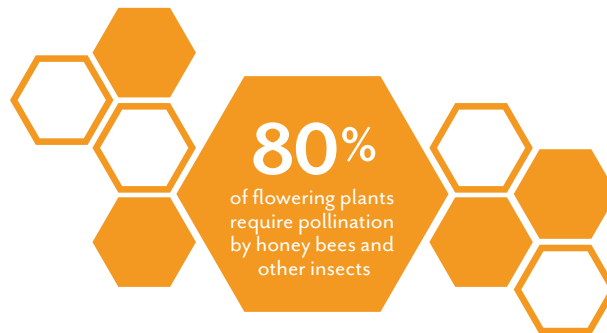
+ What has been lost?
